

AS MISSISSIPPI TERRITORY

May 7, 1798 – August 14, 1817

The following post offices, established during the Mississippi Territory period, were located within the present-day boundaries of the state of Alabama: Choctaw Trading House, Coffeeville, Coweta, Fishers, Fort Claiborne, Fort Jackson, Fort Montgomery, Fort Stoddert, Hazel Green, Hickory Flat, Huntsville, Jackson, McIntosh Bluff, Meridian, Mobile, St. Stephens, Tensaw, Tuckabatchy, and Woodstown.



Coweta Ga(Oct. 13, 1807;Ms;Black) 2,500

The site of the Lower Creek Nation town of Coweta, adjacent to or overlapping the 1813-1818 Fort Mitchell, is now occupied by the town of Fort Mitchell on the west bank of the Chattahoochee River in Russell County, Alabama. A post office was established at Coweta by February 4, 1807, and by late 1816 was serving not only the soldiers at Fort Mitchell, but the government employees of the Creek Factory just removed from Fort Hawkins, Georgia. When factor Daniel Hughes was appointed postmaster in 1818 the Postmaster General also designated Coweta a distributing office for mails passing between Alabama and Georgia. To facilitate the rapid transit of important mail between Coweta, Washington City and other points east, via Georgia postal routes, the Coweta office was administratively attached to the State of Georgia. To promote this object the Coweta postmasters used the Georgia state designation in their town markings and the Post Office Department listed Coweta in the Georgia section of its directories. Later examples of such Post Office Department administrative attachment reflected in postmarks are Gratiot's Grove, Ill. (in Michigan Territory), Indian Territory markings employing the designation "Ark", and the Ft. KEARNY O.R. and Ft. LARAMEE/OR. markings of Unorganized Territory.

Early Post Office Department records are sometimes confusing and contradictory. For example, the postmaster appointment book indicates that Coweta was changed to Fort Mitchell on October 1, 1816 and later, on May 11, 1818, it shows that Coweta was "disc[continued] - see Fort Mitchell." Also, the 1821 register lists John S. Porter as the postmaster in both Coweta and Fort Mitchell, which are both shown in Georgia. The records of the Coweta, Fort Mitchell and Creek Agency post offices, all located within a three mile radius in an isolated portion of Alabama, are so muddled that the subject offers great potential for future postal history research. Twickenham was established on December 22, 1809. The name was changed by the legislature to Huntsville on Novem- ber 25, 1811, several months after the Post Office Department established a post office as Huntsville.					
ALABAMA TERRITORY					
August 15, 1817 – December 13, 1819					
Severed from the Mississippi Territory. There is no “official” date for the establishment of the Alabama Territory. Its cre- ation was unique and several dates have been considered. The earliest date is March 3, 1817, when the general enabling territorial act was enacted. At the other extreme is December 10, 1817 when Mississippi was admitted as a state. The act of March 3 was not self-implementing, but conditioned on the formation of a Mississippi State Constitution and Government by a convention in the western part of the Mississippi Territory, together with notification to the President and action on his part. Most historians believe this occurred on August 15, 1817. Some historians suggest a slightly later date, September 25, 1817, when the first territorial governor was commissioned by President Monroe. The most commonly accepted date is used here.					
The following post offices were in operation in Alabama during the Alabama Territory period: Alabama [Town], Athens, Big Spring, Black Warrior (name changed to Tuscaloosa), Blake- ley, Burnt Corn Spring, Cahaba, Choctaw Trading House, Coffeyville, Cotton Port, Courtland, Coweta (name changed to Fort Mitchell), Eaglesville, Evansville, Fishers, Florence, Fort Claiborne (name changed to Claiborne), Fort Dale, Fort Jackson, Fort Montgomery, Fort Stoddert, Hardinsville, Hazel Green, Huntsville, Jackson, Line Creek, Marathon, Meridian, Mobile, Monacks, Mooresville, Philadelphia, Pine Flat, Pleasant Level, Russell’s Settlement, Selma, Somerville, St. Ste- phens, Suggsville, Tensaw, Triana, Washington Court House, and Woodstown.

The question of just when the Creek Agency East post office was removed from Georgia to Alabama has long been a vexing problem with postal historians. Under the tenure of agents Benj. Hawkins (1796-1816) and David B. Mitchell (1816-21) the agency compound and post office were located on the east bank of the Flint River near present day Knoxville (Crawford County), Georgia. Despite the 1822 "Table of Post Offices" listing of the Creek Agency in Baldwin County, Georgia, the compound and post office probably remained at the Flint River site during the first six years of agent John Crowell's 1821-32 tenure. But the best evidence suggests that in the summer of 1827, in response to the 1826 Treaty of Washington, Crowell moved the agency compound and post office to the Ft. Mitchell area of Russell County, Alabama. Here the post office continued until 1833 when it was discontinued and its business routed to the Ft. Mitchell post office. The placement of the Creek Agency office in the Georgia section of 1830 and 1832 post office lists indicates P.O. Dept. administrative attachment similar to that given the Coweta office.
